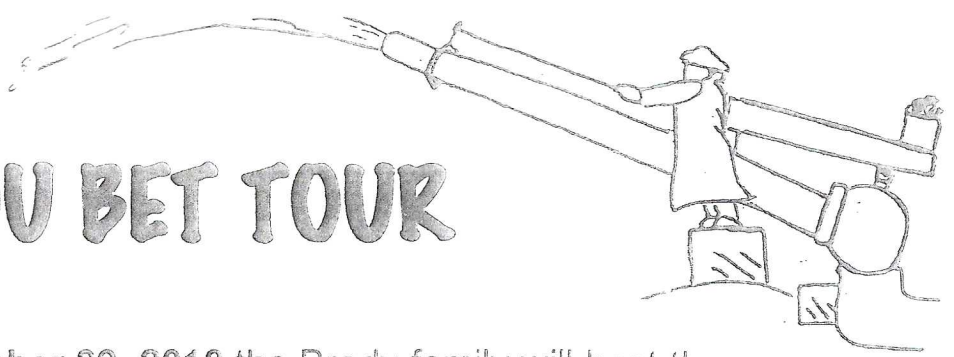


YOU BET TOUR



On Saturday September 29, 2018 the Brady family will host the 35th ANNUAL YOU BET TOUR, in cooperation with the Nevada County Historical Society. Our meeting place is the Veterans Memorial Building parking lot in Nevada City. This building is located at 415 North Pine St., Nevada City, CA 95959. Specifically, it is at the corner of Cottage and North Pine Streets.

We plan to gather at 8:30 am. You are welcome to car pool as extra vehicles may be left at the Veterans Memorial Building free of charge. We will travel by caravan to You Bet. Jerry Brady will show points of historical interest and describe some of the characters that influenced this area. Each tale is enhanced with historical photos. Stops include a former homestead, town site, overlook, and an historic cemetery. At midday, the tour reaches a hydraulic mining "diggins." At this time enjoy your lunch, as Dan Brady gives a detailed description of placer and hydraulic mining in the 1930's. Poster sketches and antique tools will help visualize this dynamic process to mine gold.

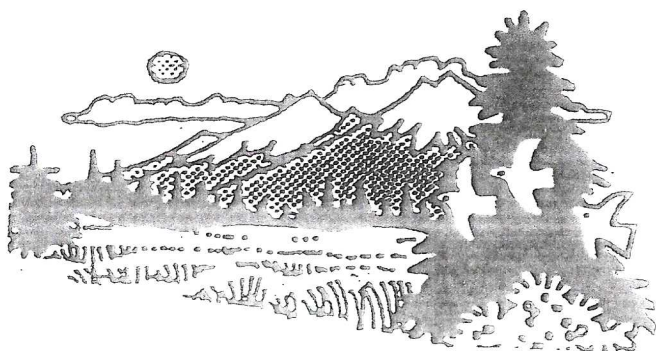
ITEMS TO REMEMBER:
